FGM TO PROVIDE COMPUTER NETWORK OPERATION (CNO) SUPPORT FUNCTIONS TO 1ST IO COMMAND (LAND)/INSCOM

The 1st Information Operations Command (Land) serves to defend Cyberspace in order to enable IO throughout the Information Environment.
